Frequently Asked Questions

Q1 What all original documents are needed at the time of admission?

Ans. a) Certificate and marksheet of class X

b) Marksheet of class XII

c) Transfer and Migration Certificates (For outstation candidate)

d) SC/ST/OBC/EWS/CW/KM certificate (in the name of the applicant) issued by the competent authority

Q2 Will the applicants be given admission on a first come, first serve policy after declaration of cut-offs?

Ans. Admissions in the DU colleges are not based on first come first serve policy. Instead, the applicant who has satisfied the criteria and cut-off for a particular course in a college will be considered for admission as per the schedule of admission specified.

Q3. I have taken admission in a college in the first list and later I am eligible for another course/college in the second list. Can I change the course/ college?

Ans. If, in subsequent lists, the applicant becomes eligible for admission in any other colleges/courses, he/she should ensure eligibility by confirming with the College. Once certain, he/she can withdraw from the previous college through the online portal and take admission in the second college.

Q4. I met the 1st cut-off list but I haven't taken admission due to some reason. Can I take admission in 2nd list?

Ans. Those who come under first cut off but seeking admission in the 2nd cut off can be admitted only on the last day (towards the last hour) of the 2nd cutoff, provided seats are available.

Q5 I have taken science in my XII standard, and now I want to take admission in humanities. Will there be any deduction of marks for the stream change?

Ans. There will be deduction of 2.5% on stream change for honours courses

Q6 Once I have taken admission in a particular subject, can I change my subject in same college in next cut off?

Ans: Yes, you can change your subject, but first ensure your eligibility by confirming with the concern department. Once they are certain, you can withdraw from the previous course through the online portal and take admission again.

Q7 Will there be any disadvantage for gap year candidates?

Ans: No, there won't be any disadvantage for gap year students; however, they need to upload the necessary documents while applying for DU admission 2020. And also submit an affidavit during admission.

Q8. What are the BA program combinations available in your college?

Mathematic + Economics

History + Political Science

Philosophy + Psychology

History + English (elective)

Nutrition Health Education + Music

Nutrition Health Education + ESB

Music + Sanskrit

Physical Education + Political Science

Physical Education + Hindi

Q9 Can I enroll myself in a certificate language course along with my regular graduation course?

Ans: Yes, many colleges offer part-time certificate courses in office management, foreign languages etc.

Q10 I have OBC certificate issued in 1st February, 2020 will it be valid for the admission?

If at that time if you have OBC certificate dated on or before 31st march 2020, you may be admitted provisionally. An undertaking will be submitting stating the latest OBC certificated issued after March 31, 2020 will be submitted within 7 days from your admission. Otherwise your admission will stand cancelled.

Q11 When can I apply for hostel accommodation?

Ans. You have to apply in a separate form of the college for hostel accommodation. However, you must note that a college seat will not guarantee a seat in the hostel.

Q12 How do I get fees back after cancellation/change of college?

The DU admission fee paid in the previous cutoff list will be refunded (after deducting the cancellation fee) and visible in the “Wallet” section of the dashboard. When the candidate pays the admission fee, any extra amount left in the “Wallet” section of the dashboard will be refunded to his/ her account after DU admissions 2020 are closed
