## **Report of Political Science Association Activities 2020-21**

To facilitate critical intellectual thinking, academic excellence and educational aspirations of the students, *Republica*, the Political Science Association organized several curricular and extra-curricular activities during the academic session 2020-21. The session began with an inhouse Skill Development Programme (E-SDP), organised from 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> August 2020, to enable the students to become competent and confident users of various ICT tools. Dr. Moitree Bhattacharya, Dr. Shachi Chawla, Dr. Madhu Damani, and Dr. Deepak Bhaskar were the resource persons. The programme was attended by more than 200 students.

The Political Science Association organized a Webinar on 'India-China Relations in the Contemporary Times' on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020. Prof. Swaran Singh, Chairperson, Centre for International Politics, Organization and Disarmament (CIPOD), Jawaharlal Nehru University, highlighted the historic interconnections and the complex and dynamic relations between India and China in the contemporary times. Dr. Deepak Bhaskar, Assistant Professor, Daulat Ram College, focused on significant issues and debates that concern Indo-China relations. The session was followed by an interactive and enriching discussion.

An orientation programme was organized for the students of first year on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2020 to familiarise the students with numerrous curricular and co-curricular opportunities in the college, and the department, in particular. A brief presentation on several programmes organised and participated by the students during the previous years inspired and motivated the freshers to get involved in the various activities of the department.
