

## COMNEUR- The Commerce Association, Daulat Ram College

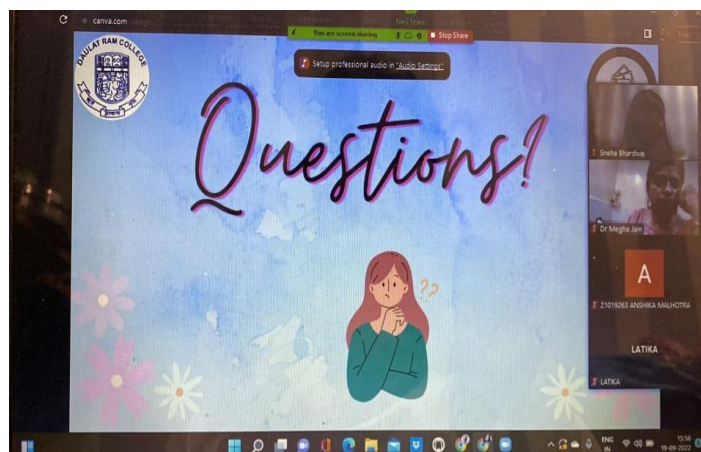

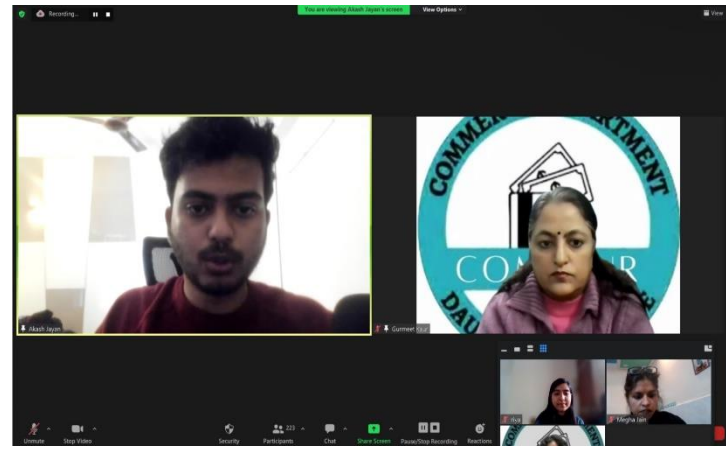
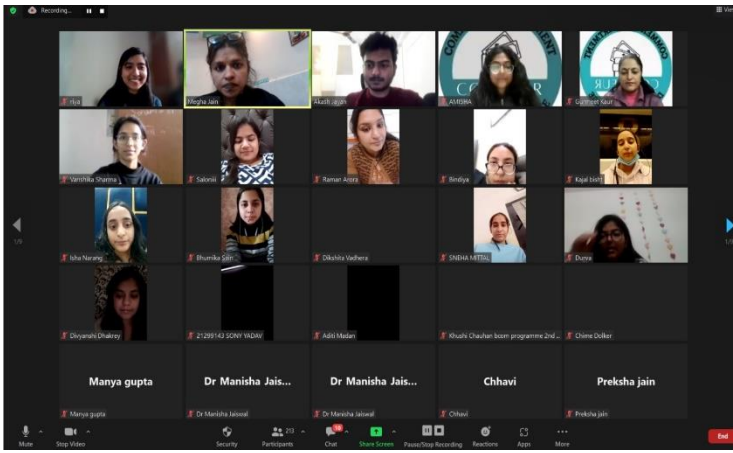

We bring forward a glimpse of the events, activities and workshops organised by our department during Comneur’s session of 2022-23.

On September 19, 2022, a webinar on ‘Understanding the dynamics of smart investment’ was held through ZOOM (an online meeting platform) at 3pm with a presence of more than 220 students from various disciplines and courses. The session was taken by eloquent speakers Mayank Dwivedi Sir, Amit Giri Sir and Amit Grover Sir. At the end of the session, the speakers expressed their gratitude and appreciated the comneur team for carrying out the session so well and the audience for being patient and enthusiastic throughout the session.



Furthermore, Comneur in collaboration with Groww organised a virtual webinar on the benefits of early investments.
