Nomination form duly filled in and signed by the candidate along with passport size photo affixed at the appropriate box 2. Along with nomination form candidates have to sign a declaration and an undertaking regarding their eligibility and conformation of strict adherence to the rules of elections and code of conduct of elections 3. Each nomination is to be proposed and seconded by an eligible voter in writing of nomination from 4. Copy of class X examination showing the date of birth of the candidate 5. Copy of previous year marksheet 6. Copy of current year college identity card 7. Copy of current year fee slip 8. Confirmation of adherence to rules of elections and code of conduct of elections 9. Copy of current year (2017-18) valid identity card of the student proposing and seconding the nomination
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Salient Points of the code of conduct of elections to be noted and adhered to by all candidates and students

1. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different caste and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
2. All students shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting all the activities which are considered to be 'corrupt practices' and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters
3. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlet, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing.
4. No candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the University/college campus including the website and facebook page of University/Colleges for any purpose whatsoever. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any University/College property.
5. The use of loudspeaker, vehicle and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited
6. Contravention of any of the above provisions and other provisions of code of conduct may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his candidature, or her elected post, as the case may be. The college/ University authorities may also take appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator

With this notification, the Code of Conduct of Elections comes into operations and any violation of the same shall result in disqualification/election of the candidate countermanded and shall invite punitive action.

All concerned, especially candidates seeking election as office bearers of DRCSU, are requested to go through in detail the Code of Conduct for Students' Elections, Lyngdoh Committee recommendations accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Order of the National Green Tribunal of July 18, 2016, as available on the Delhi University website (www.du.ac.in).
