National Cadets Corps at DRC offers disciplined adventure to its cadets. Year 2021 for our NCC cadets began with setting up of an online COVID helpdesk during the second wave of the pandemic. The cadets relentlessly helped the patients to find valid sources of oxygen cylinders and provided updates about availability of hospital beds. Later on 26th July, 2021 Kargil Vijay Diwas was celebrated with an enriching talk on 'Kargil – A remembrance' by Col.Karnail Singh, Deputy Commandant and Chief Instructor (DCI) at the NCC Officers Training Academy, Gwalior. Various inter-college and inter-coy competitions were organised as part of Azaadi ka Amrut Mahotsav to honor the grit, determination, valor, and brotherhood of our courageous hearts.

On the 75th anniversary of our nation's independence, NCC DRC hosted a series of competitions and a webinar on 'Importance of National Integration on Nation Building' by Rear Admiral Alok Bhatnagar, former Additional Director General of HQ NCC and recipient of the US president's "Legion of Merit" award.

On 26th August, 2021 our cadets who believe in making the world a better place for the voiceless celebrated International Dog Day by feeding approximately 100 dogs at north campus area. They displayed the importance of being kind and sympathetic to the needs of these innocent creatures and pledged to continue to be so in the future.

On 28th October, 2021 a community awareness drive on "Ills of single use plastic," was organised at our adopted village - Sangam Vihar. The cadets presented a Nukkad Natak and an hour long rally which was witnessed by audience of all age groups.

In December, 2021 we welcomed our first year cadets. 400 prospective cadets among first year students went through a rigorous selection process, out of which 59 cadets were selected to become a part of NCC at DRC. An orientation programme of the selected cadets was held on 16th January, 2022.

Every year we celebrate our Republic Day on 26 January with immense pride and fervor to honour the date on which our Constitution, "Bharatiya Samvidhan" came into effect. The theme for the Republic Day Parade of 2022 was India @75' to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence. This year 9 of our cadets participated in PM rally and 1 of our cadet participated in prestigious Republic Day Camp.

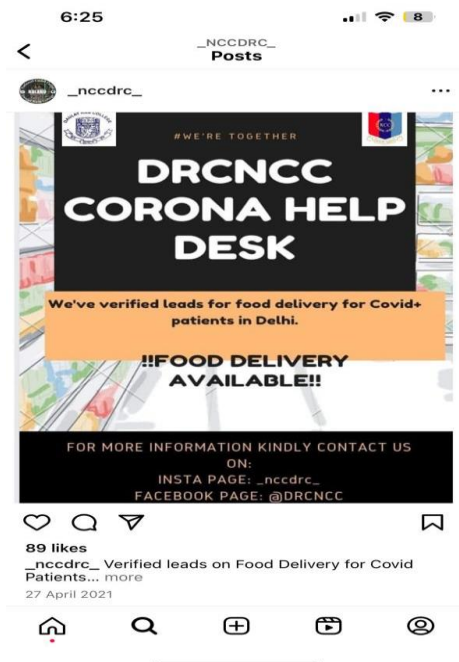

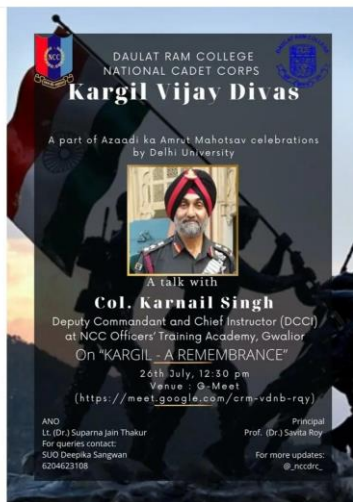
Title of the Event: Kargil Vijay Diwas

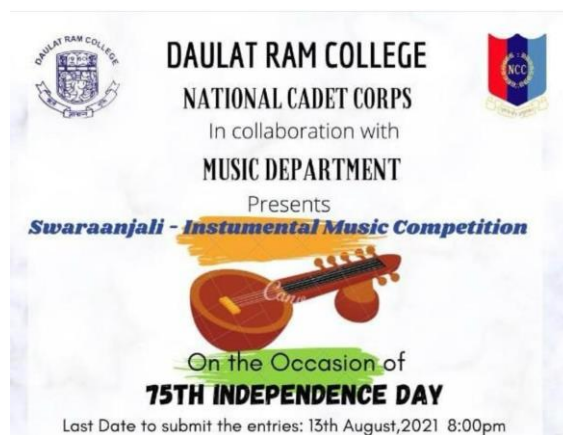
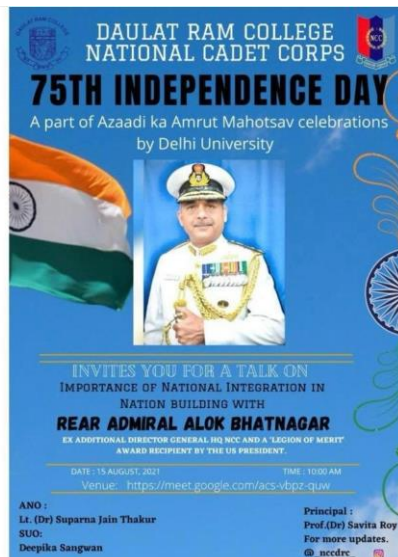

Title of the Event: Stray Dog Feeding drive

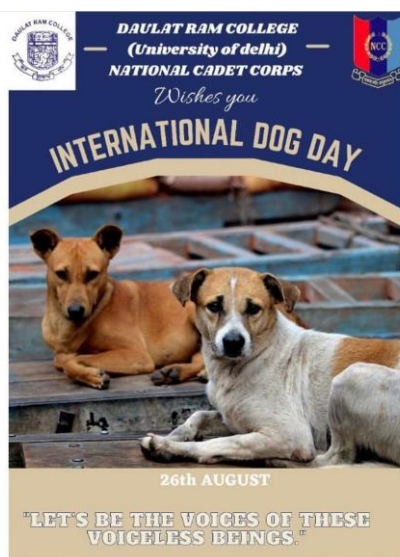

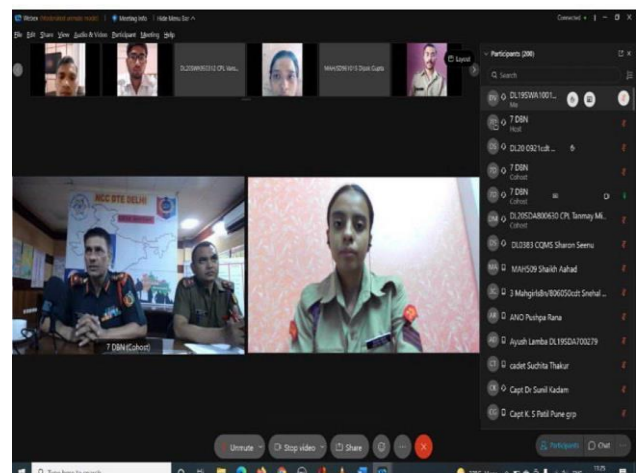
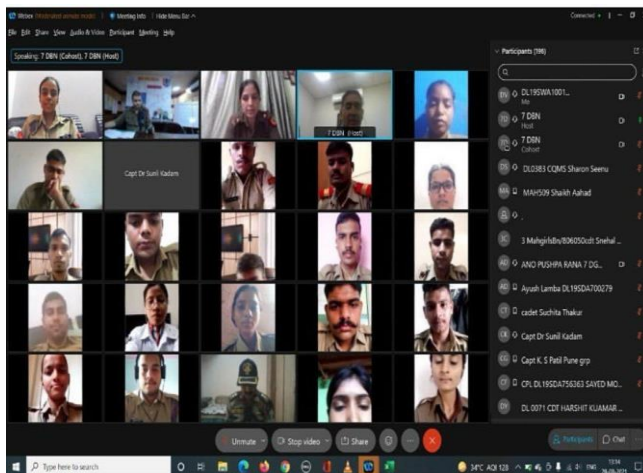
Title of the Event: Online Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat (EBSB - IX) Camp

Date: 19th Dec to 24th Dec 2021

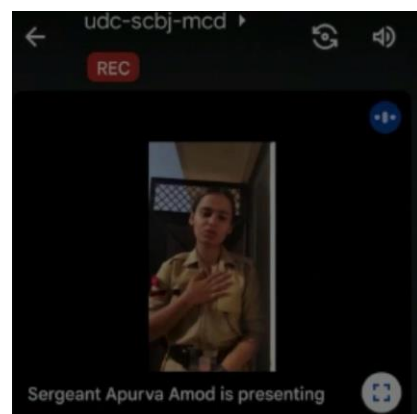
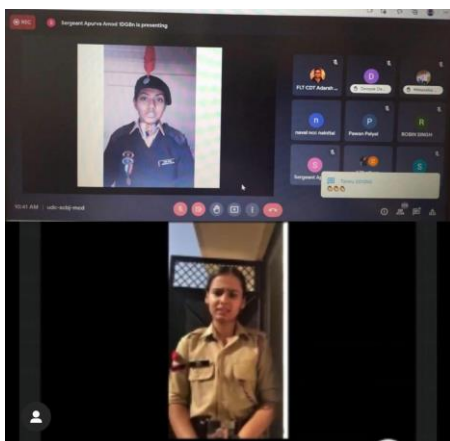

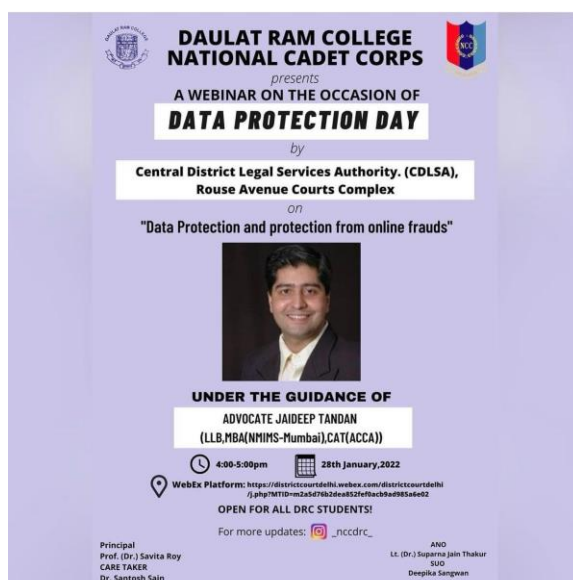

Title of the Event: Republic Day Camp

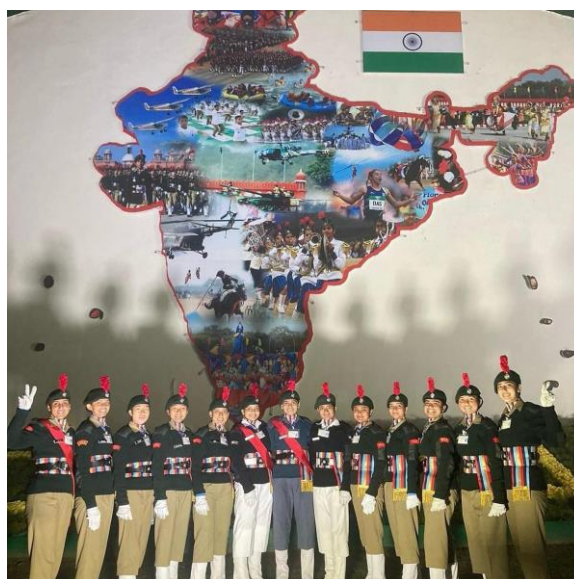
Date: 01 Jan to 29 Jan, 2022
