**Water proofing treatment work on roof terrace of Hostel Building (B, C & D Wing) at Daulat Ram College Hostel.**

01	<p>Dismantling of roof terrace tile jointing and cleaning with iron brush and preparation of surface as required for treatment of roofs, balconies, terraces etc consisting of following operations: (Without mortar waterproofing)</p> <p>a) Applying a slurry coat of neat cement using 3.5kg/sqm of cement admixed with water proofing compound conforming to Cico 151 Acrylic Polymer approved by Engineer-in-charge over the slab including adjoining walls up to 120mm height including cleaning the surface before treatment.</p> <p>b).Applying a layer with Cement admixed with water proofing compound conforming to Cico 151 Acrylic Polymer and approved by Engineer-in-charge with an average thickness of 6 mm and treating similarly the adjoining walls up to 120 mm height including rounding of junctions of walls and slabs.</p> <p>c) After two days of proper curing applying a coat of cement slurry using 3.5kg/sqm of cement admixed joint less cement admixed with water proofing compound conforming to Cico 151 Acrylic Polymer and approved by Engineer-in-charge and finally finishing the surface with neat cement slurry.</p> <p>d) The whole terrace so finished shall be flooded with water for a minimum period of two weeks for curing and for final test. All above operations to be done and as directed and specified by the Engineer-in-charge:</p>	900.00 Sqm.		
02	<p>a).Applying a layer with Cement mortar with admixed water proofing compound conforming to Cico 151 Acrylic Polymer and approved by Engineer-in-charge with an average thickness of 36 mm with 12mm slope with making pattern of 300X300mm square 3mm deep with glass.</p> <p>b). Treating similarly the adjoining walls up to 120mm height including rounding of junctions of walls and slabs.</p>	107.00 Sqm

### Terms and Conditions:-

1. The successful Contractor will have to execute an Agreement with the College on the basis of form PWD-8 or CPWD which can be seen before tendering in the office of the undersigned.
2. Time allowed for the work from the 7 day after the date of written order to commence the work and will be completed within 4 weeks.
3. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications.
4. The Contractor will have to get sample of all materials and all fittings before using them on work.
5. The Contractor shall see the site of work before Tendering at his own cost.
6. In case of error in description of any DSR item, given in the schedule, the description given in the CPWD schedule of rates shall be final and no claim on account of error shall be made.
7. The College reserves the right to split the works among the tenders and the decision of Principal shall be final and binding on the tenders.
8. The acceptance of the tender will rest with the Principal / GB Hostel Committee who does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in which any or the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled is liable to be rejected.
9. This tender shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of tender. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or made any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the College then the College without pre-judice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeited the Earnest Money.
10. The site shall be cleared of all loose stones, materials rubbish or all kinds as well as tar felt. All the area will be cleaned as required as directed. Nothing extra will be paid on this account.
11. The Contractor shall not deposit materials on site, which will cause inconvenience to the staff/students. The undersigned may require the contractor to remove any materials which are considered to be dangerous or inconvenient to the staff/student or cause them to be removed, at the contractors cost.

12. The Contractor shall furnish performance security equal to 5% of the value of work order within 7 days from the date of issue of Work Order. The performance Security should be in form of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Principal, Daulat Ram College Hostel, or in form of Bank Guarantee of the equivalent amount as security towards the fulfillment of work order. No claim would be entertained against the College Hostel in respect of interest of the deposit.
13. The proceeds of the performance security shall be payable to the Contract are as compensation for any loss resulting from the contractor's failure to complete its obligations under the contract.
14. The performance security will be discharged by the Contract are after completion of the contractor's performance obligations including any warranty obligations under the contract, after completion of 6 months from the date of agreement.
15. All materials to be used on the work shall be of reputed makes/ISI marked, as per the sample approved.
16. The successful contractor or his representative should be made available at work site during the execution of the work.
17. The contractor has to make his own arrangement of T&P required for execution of the work and no claim will be admissible on this account.
18. In case the work site is not made available to the contractor according the programme, no claim will be admissible on this account.
