- **Full Paper:** The paper should be in 1500-2500 words, with 1.5 line spacing.
- **Format:** MS Word format using Times New Roman/Unicode/Mangal, 12 pt. font size.
- **Author Info:** Highlight the corresponding author's name with an asterisk (*) or underline and include a complete mailing address.
- **Plagiarism:** Under 10% similarity (using tools like Turnitin/iThenticate)
- **AI Content:** Strictly prohibited or must be disclosed
- **Full paper,** if applicable, be named same as the abstract file name and should be sent to ncep2026@dr.du.ac.in with the **theme as the subjectline**.
