CALL FOR PAPERS

The discipline of Psychology occupies a special status among the social sciences as it encompasses and endorses both theory and practice. Since the time of its inception, the discipline of Psychology has grown extensively in terms of the vast number of theories and models that attempt to capture the nuances of various aspects of both individual and social life. At the same time rigorous efforts have been made to apply the scholarship from theory and practice towards understanding and providing active intervention in the areas of mental health, social issues, organizational behavior, as well as, to enhance happiness and well-being at individual and collective levels.

However, at this juncture, when we have entered the 21st century, it is time to pause and reflect about the aims and objectives of Psychology and whether it has been able to benefit society from its vast expanse of knowledge. It can be observed that whereas the findings and principles of Psychology have great potential for improving life and contributing positively to the society, there seems to be a gap in terms of knowledge generated and its application to various aspects of individual and social life. As Psychologists we need to make an earnest attempt to bridge this gap. Hence, this Conference with its theme “*Psychological Applications and Interventions: Reaching Out and Making A Difference*” makes a sincere attempt to explore and address this significant issue. The Conference aims to reiterate that the importance of Psychology lies not only in knowledge generation but also utilizing that knowledge to help those in need and therefore to emphasize the integration of theory, research and practice. This Conference aims to provide a platform to academicians, practitioners as well as other stakeholders to deliberate upon this vital issue and to chart out a future course of action for Psychology to achieve its desired aim of “Reaching Out and Making a Difference”.

WORKSHOPS

On the second day of the Conference, 19th January, 2018 (post-lunch) 3 parallel workshops to be conducted by experts in three areas, i.e., Clinical, OB/HRM, and Expressive Arts have been planned to develop a better understanding of the applications of Psychology. Delegates who wish to attend the same may indicate that in the Registration form as well as submit the requisite fee. Delegates would be accommodated for the workshops on a first-come-first serve basis.

SUB THEMES

The subthemes revolve around the main theme of the Conference: “ Psychological Applications and Interventions: Reaching Out and Making A Difference”. Papers are invited which deal with the psychological applications and interventions in various domains of life. At the same time some new and emerging approaches in Psychology have also been included to have an exhaustive list of sub-themes so that the applications Psychology can be understood in a comprehensive way. Sub-themes of the Conference include, though are not limited to, the following-

- ◆ Psychology through the Life Span
- ◆ Community Out Reach: Linking Individuals and Environments
- ◆ Mental Health: Awareness, Promotion and Intervention
- ◆ Education: Knowledge or Employment, Life-skill Development, Lifelong Education
- ◆ Interpersonal Relationships: Family, Love, Romance, Friendship, and Intimate Relationships
- ◆ Gender: Construction, Identity/(ies), Relations, Globalization and Gender
- ◆ Media: Social media, Advertising, Consumer behaviour
- ◆ Psychology of the marginalized: Inclusion-Exclusion of individuals and groups
- ◆ Recreation and Sports: Training Mind and Body, Psychology of Performance Enhancement
- ◆ Positive Psychology
- ◆ Indigenous Approaches: Transformation of self, Application of ancient texts in everyday life, Life-style intervention
- ◆ Psychological Assessment: Research and inquiry, Career Choices and Placements, Guidance and Counselling, Selection and Training, Performance Appraisal

PAPER SUBMISSION

- Abstracts must be sent in the form of a Microsoft Word document by email latest by 30th September, 2017
- Full papers must be sent in by 31st October, 2017
- Papers must be written in English
- The following information must be included on the first page of the submission
 - ⇒ Title of the paper & sub-theme
 - ⇒ Name(s) of the author(s)
 - ⇒ Institutional affiliation
 - ⇒ Contact address, telephone and email address
 - ⇒ Author's name(s) should be on the title page only
- Papers and abstracts will be accepted only if the manuscript has not been published, presented or accepted for presentation/publication at any other conference/journal
- All accepted papers will be published
- In case you would like your paper to be published, kindly submit the publication fee in addition to the registration fee
- Only one copy per paper will be provided, more can be accessed at an extra cost

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER

- * The manuscript must be typed in 1.5 spacing, 12 point Times New Roman
- * The length of the papers should not exceed 5000 words excluding the abstract (maximum 300 words)
- * All reference must be in the APA format

FORMAT FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

- * The poster should present a clear idea of the research paper.
- * The presenter(s) are required to be present during the poster presentation session.
- * The poster should be made with the following dimensions:
28 inches x 22 inches
