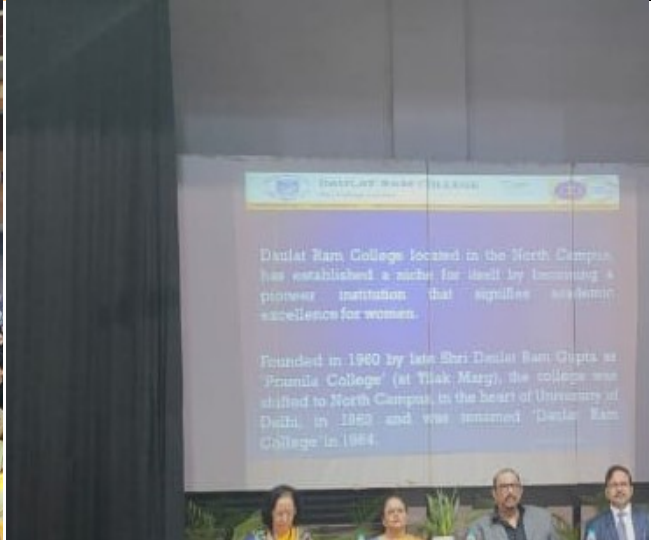




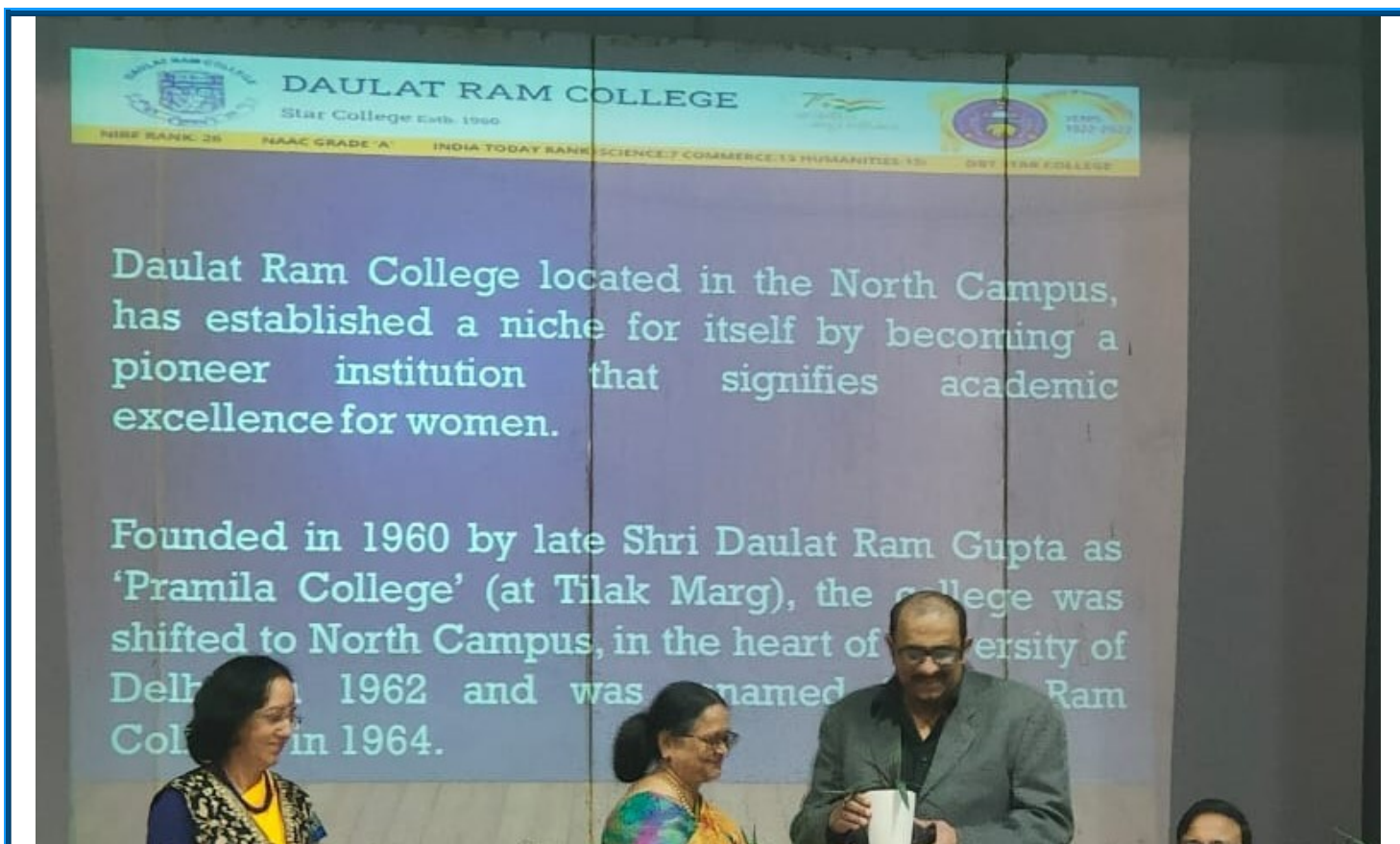
Daulat Ram College extended a warm welcome to the newly admitted students in the grand orientation day program held on 3rd November 2022 in Sadbbhavana Bhawan, the college auditorium. The event was hosted by the Principal of Daulat Ram College. The event began with lamp lighting by the dignitaries along with the Saraswati Vandana recited by the Music Society, DRC. It was followed by a cultural program conducted by the Dance Society, DRC headed by the ECA convener Dr. Darshan.





Honourable Chairperson of the Governing Body, Mr. Mukul Gupta, addressed the newly admitted students with his inspiring words of wisdom, followed by a pathbreaking address by Mr. Vivek Prakash, Indian Revenue Personnel Service. He highlighted the role of the students in nation building which has become more pertinent during the Amrit Kaal or 75 years of independence.
