The two-days programme had 12 sessions, running simultaneously in 3 groups to facilitate better interaction and learning experience of the students. The sessions were taken by 9 faculty members of the department as resource persons. The sessions conducted involved extensive coverage of IT tools to enable students to engage in online classes confidently and maximize their learning using virtual platforms. The sessions were a huge success in reaching out to students and making them comfortable in using these tools. Over 200 students enthusiastically interacted during the sessions, clarified their queries and satisfactorily completed their session assessments. They shared their knowledge on various topics with the students like the basic concepts of mutual funds, asset diversification as an investment strategy and also discussed various factors in the capital market that support and motivate investors to stay invested in the market, such as ease of investment, level of transparency, transparency in the transaction process in secondary markets, and so on. The webinar witnessed more than 220 attendees throughout the session including both students from different disciplines

and respected senior and junior teachers from different departments. The webinar proved quite engaging for students from streams such as BA (Prog), BSc, BCom (Hons), BCom (Prog), and BA (Economics). It was a really fruitful session for both the fresher's and the final year students.

#### 4. Webinar on “Basics of Income Tax and e-filing of ITR for Salaried Individuals for FY 2020-21”

The Department of Commerce, Daulat Ram College organized a webinar on “Basics of Income Tax and e-filing of ITR for Salaried Individuals for FY 2020-21” on 1st September 2021. The session started at 11:30 a.m. Via Zoom platform and witnessed enthusiastic participation from over 300 participants from diverse fields of study.

The session was conducted by Dr. SB Rathore by explaining the important aspects of taxation for salaried individuals such as: detailed comparison of the old tax regime with the new regime along with a numerical example; information pertaining to due date for filing and fees leviable for late filing of ITRs; process involved in formation of PAN, TAN and BSR Code and; modalities involved in tax planning etc. Dr. Rathore also conducted a practical session on e-filing of ITR taking an actual case during which he guided the participants on how to login to the new e-filing portal, download detailed Form 26 AS, edit information while filing ITR, as well as the process involved in e-verification and submission of the return. Thereafter, the question-answer session witnessed a tremendous response from participants who eagerly awaited their turn to get their queries resolved by Dr. Rathore. The responses by Dr. Rathore on various frequently asked questions along with few specific queries made this part of the webinar very engaging and enriching.
