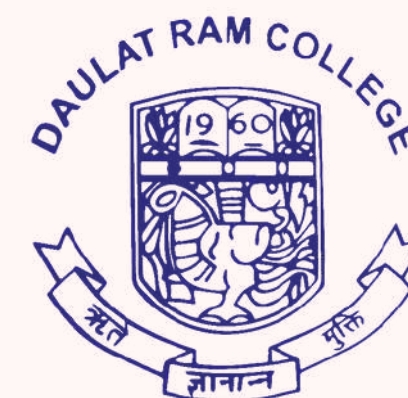

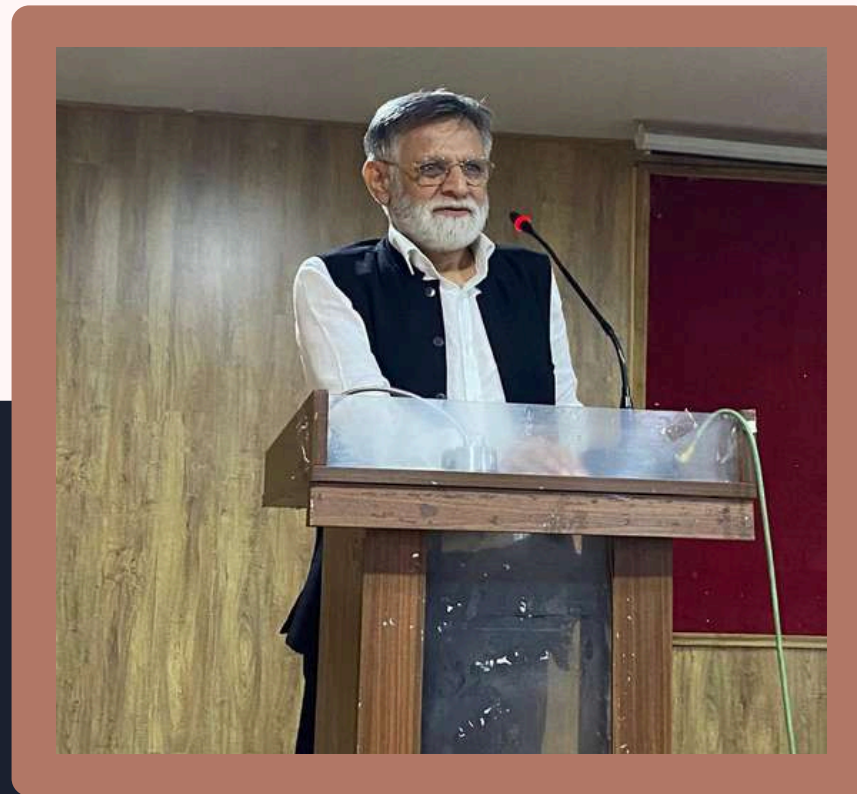
Rajghat, Gandhi Darshan and Darshan Samiti (Educational Trip): **30th September, 2022**

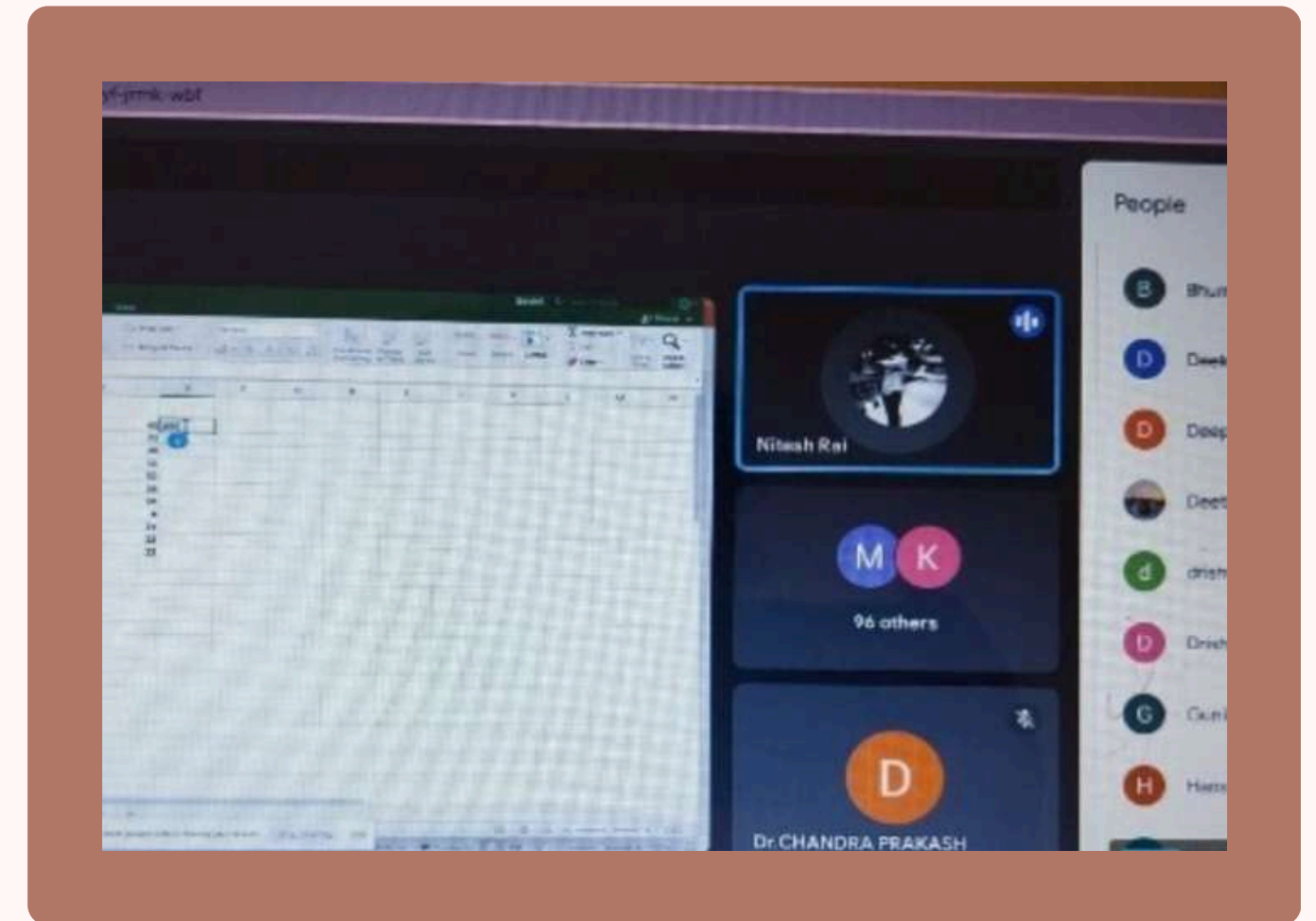
Skill Development Program:

Speaker Session: 18 October 2024

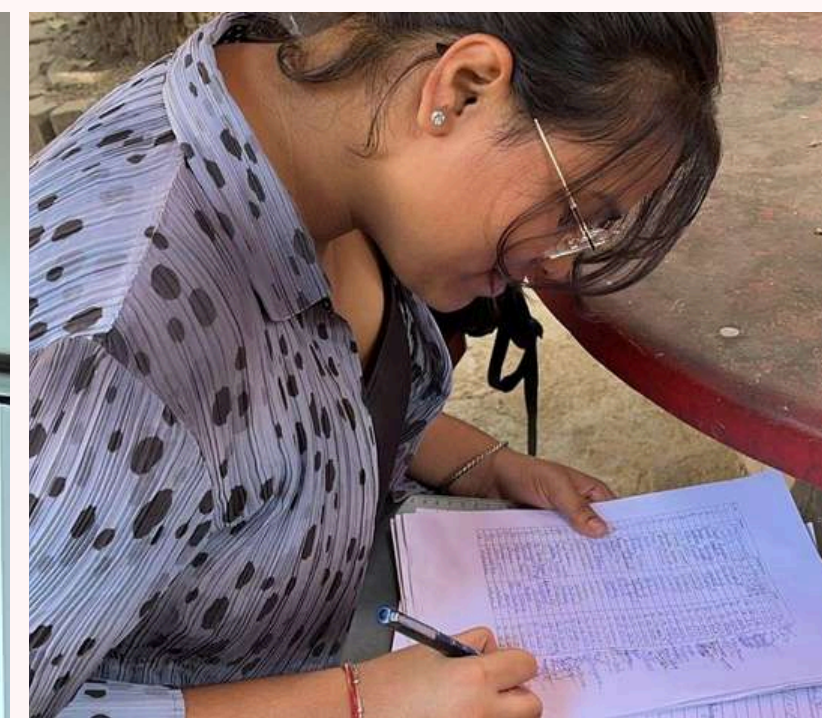
