EVENT SUMMARY

Vasundhara, the Botanical Society and Magic Lantern & Sepia, The film & Photography Society, Daulat Ram College jointly organized a Nature Photography Workshop Series-I from 12:30 – 02:30 pm on 30th and 31st October 2023, in the Botany Lecture Theatre of Daulat Ram College, University of Delhi.

The invited speaker for the event was Ms. Shraddha Gupta, Head Photographer and Creative Head, Neytrya photography (the shutter shots).

The first day lecture began with the question “What is Photography”. Ms. Shraddha explained the basics of taking a good photo by demonstrating by number of photographs like dense forest, Ganga ghat, temple, cloud, bird, sky etc. In this process, Ms Shraddha demonstrated the students the tricks of taking good photographs in bright and dim light conditions, and the difference in outdoor and indoor photography. She defined the camera very beautifully by her artistic way. She taught the DSLR camera features in detail. The program offered opportunities for reflection, self-discovery, and photography skill improvement, fostering connections with fellow photographers, ensuring maximum inspiration and enjoyment at all levels in the participants. The workshop offered a fun and engaging experience for both beginners and advanced photographers. It covered techniques for nature photography, exposure triangles, macro photography tips, backlight shooting, long exposures, and the local ecosystems capturing techniques. Participants learn forest bathing techniques and mindfulness exercises, ensuring a deeper understanding of nature.

On second day of the series, Ms. Shraddha taught the hands-on experience of a DSLR camera.

The session on real-time field photography was also very interesting. All the participants were allowed to explore different green locations within the college campus, like the front lawn, the Botanical garden, and Rangshala ground for taking photographs of the Natural world.

A question and answer session was held at the end of both the days wherein Ms Shraddha had an interaction with the students. Once the lectures were delivered, a quiz was organized for the students. The quiz was based on the lessons taught in the workshop and the grades were awarded to each participant. A post-workshop Photography competition was also conducted in which one nature photograph per participant was submitted and top three winners with the best clicked photos were awarded certificates. The seminar concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Asmita Gupta and Dr. Shagun Danda, the Staff Advisors of the Botanical Society.

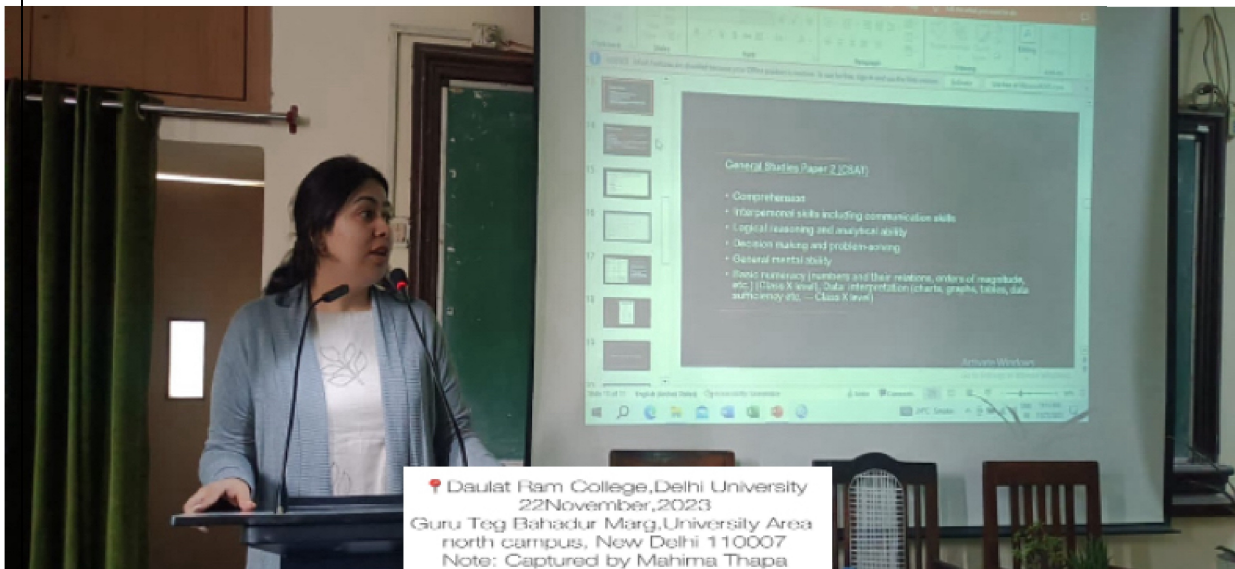

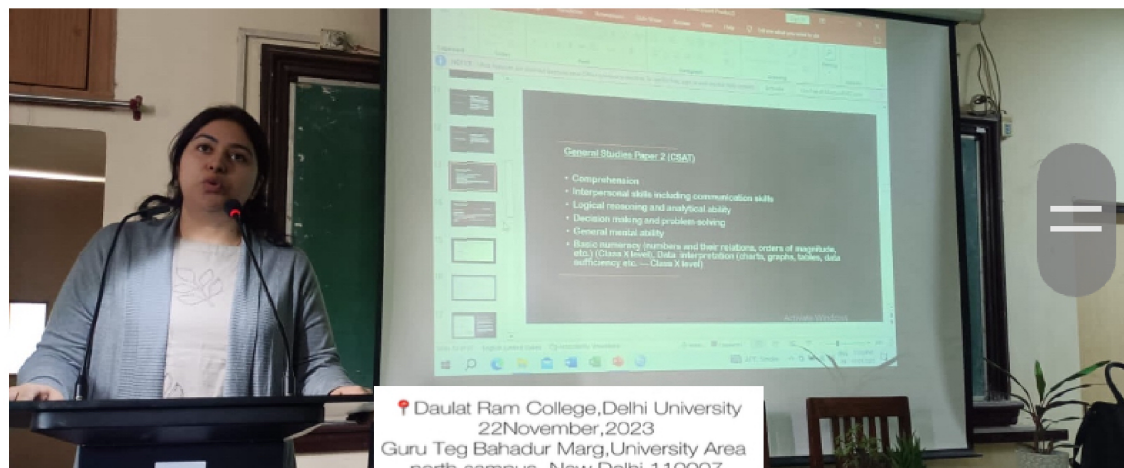

Summary of the event:
