# **ANNUAL REPORT**

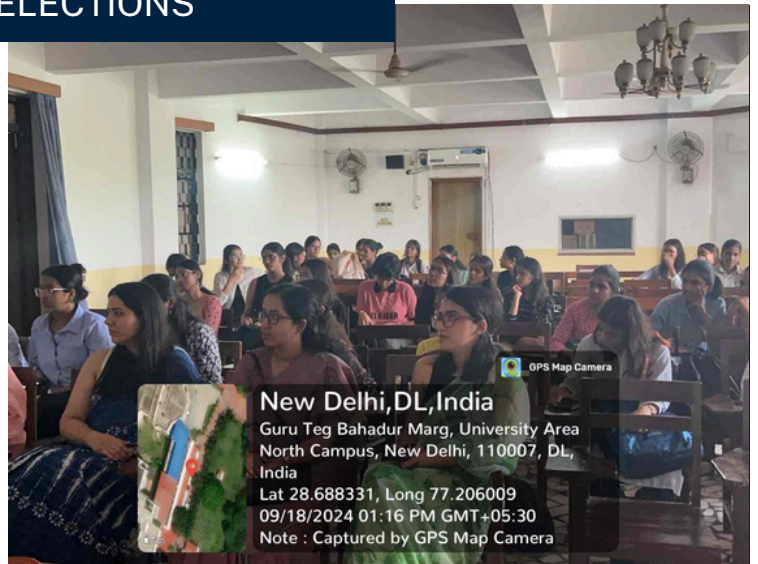
**2024 - 2025**

These activities have fostered a culture of learning, collaboration, and professional growth, from enlightening educational excursions and career counselling sessions to engaging alumni conversations and innovative policy discussions. Each event has provided our students and faculty with the opportunity to explore critical economic issues, connect with distinguished guests and alumni, and gain insights that will shape their academic and professional futures. This report aims to present a comprehensive overview of the Associations' ventures this year.

## UNION ELECTIONS

On September 19th, 2024, the Economics Association, Eclat, hosted its annual Union election, drawing enthusiastic participation from students across all academic years. This longstanding tradition serves as a cornerstone of our academic community, as aspiring candidates fervently campaign for coveted roles within the Department Union, including President, Co-President, Vice President, General Secretary, and Treasurer.



The electoral process culminates in a hallmark event: the open house speech, where candidates eloquently present their visions and manifestos in the presence of esteemed faculty members and fellow students. This democratic exercise underscores our commitment to student governance and involvement, as each vote contributes to the selection of the most qualified individuals to lead the Department Union. As tradition dictates, the election process concludes with the casting of votes, ensuring that the deserving Union is duly elected to uphold the values and aspirations of our esteemed association.

## SEMINAR ON CRITICAL THINKING AND DESIGN THINKING



On October 15th, Dr. Sheetal Chadda, an alumna of Daulat Ram College's Psychology Department, conducted an engaging session on Critical Thinking and Design Thinking. With 26 years of experience in teaching and brief corporate exposure, she emphasized the lack of critical thinking in India and explained its importance in everyday life.

She introduced the RED model—Recognize Assumptions, Evaluate Arguments, and Draw Conclusions—and explained the Ladder of Inference using interactive case studies that encouraged student participation. Dr. Chadda also explained Design Thinking through a simplified process: Empathize, Define, Ideate, Prototype, and Test.

The session was informative and thought-provoking, leaving students inspired by her practical insights and dynamic approach.

## SEMINAR ON 21ST CENTURY SOFT SKILLS AND BUSINESS COMMUNICATION

On October 15th, the Economics Department of Daulat Ram College held a seminar on “21st Century Soft Skills and the 7 C’s of Communication” led by Prof. Shirley Rex from GIMS. The session began with a discussion on personality and its link to communication and leadership. Prof. Rex emphasized the importance of soft skills, particularly effective communication, professional grooming, and a positive attitude. An interactive activity on corporate dressing etiquette added practical insight and pens were distributed as tokens of appreciation. It was an enriching session that helped students enhance their confidence and professional presence.

FAGUNI AWASTHI

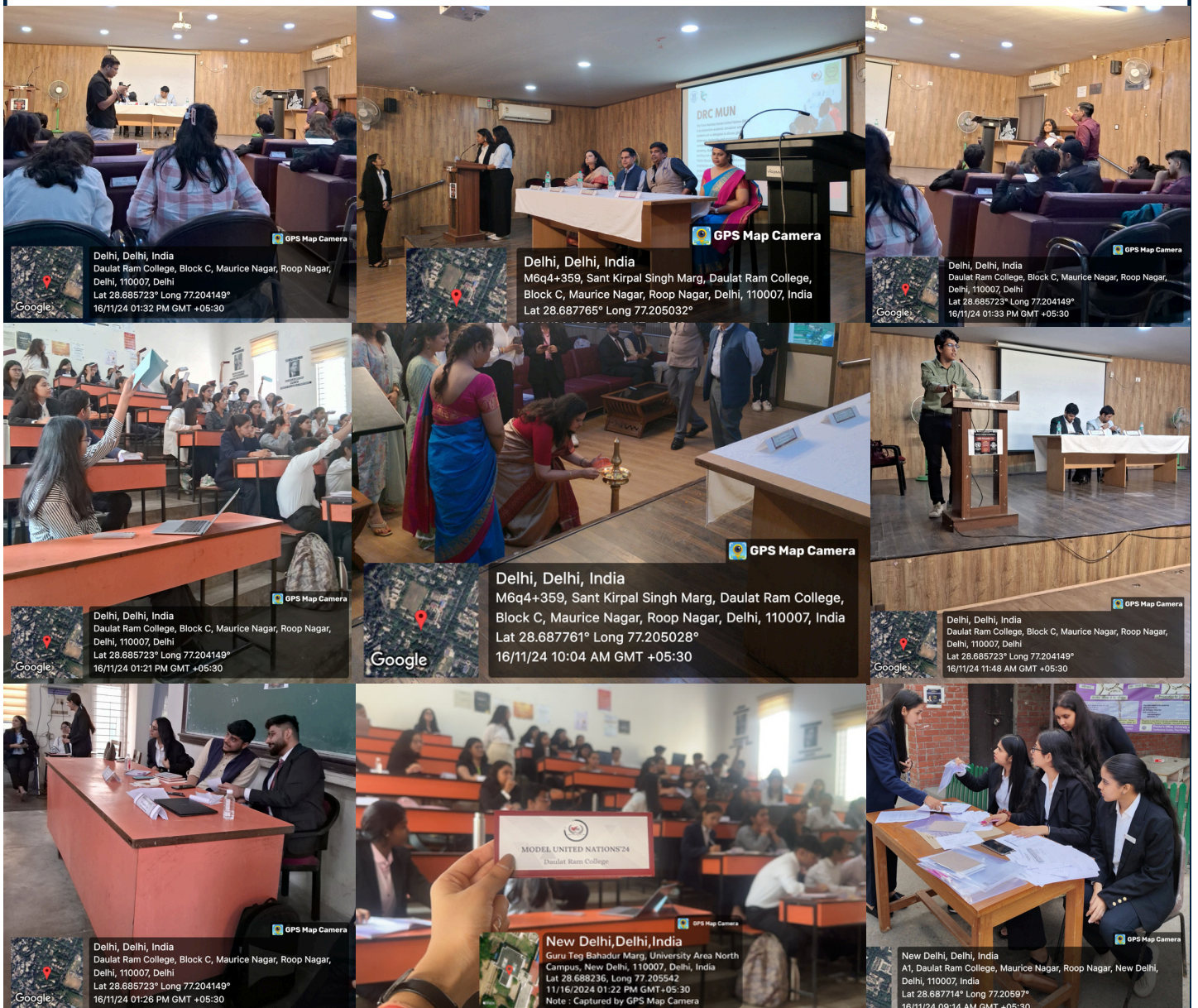

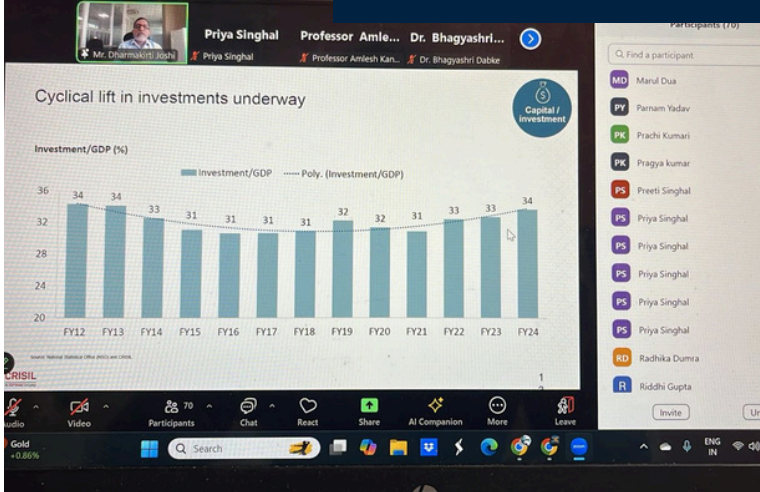
# DRC MODEL UNITED NATIONS

The Daulat Ram College Model United Nations (MUN) held on November 16, 2024, was organized by Éclat, the Economics Association, in collaboration with Yuva Manthan MUN. The event began with an inspiring opening ceremony featuring keynote speeches, a ceremonial lamp lighting, and recognition of student contributions. It provided a platform for students to engage in meaningful discussions on global and national issues.

The UNGA committee debated “Achieving Carbon Neutrality by 2050,” emphasizing sustainability and global cooperation, while the Lok Sabha addressed “Viksit Bharat 2047” through the lens of youth-focused policies and reforms. The closing ceremony celebrated the event’s success, with awards for outstanding delegates and a motivational message from Secretary-General Charvi Behl. The MUN encouraged critical thinking, collaboration, and leadership among students.



## WEBINAR ON QUEST FOR EQUITABLE GROWTH



Éclat, in collaboration with MDAE, hosted a webinar on “Quest for Equitable Growth” with Mr. Dharmakirti Joshi, Chief Economist at CRISIL. He highlighted India’s strong GDP growth post-pandemic, driven by investments, and compared it with other major economies. He also addressed rising food inflation and its impact on the poor, noting the RBI’s limited control over localized price surges.

Mr. Joshi projected a 6.7% average GDP growth till FY31 and emphasized key strategies like strengthening infrastructure, boosting reforms, and increasing female workforce participation. He urged the youth to actively engage in nation-building, stressing that despite global challenges, equitable growth is achievable through commitment and collaboration.

## CAREER COUNSELING SESSION

A career counselling session was conducted by Dr. Pooja Sharma on December 16, 2024, where she discussed various career prospects in the field of economics. She highlighted the achievements of the department’s alumni, including those who have pursued higher studies at prestigious institutions like Harvard and LSE. Dr. Sharma also informed students about the range of programmes, workshops, and internships organized by the Economics Department throughout the year to support academic and professional development. The session provided valuable guidance and inspiration for students planning their future paths.



## CAT FOR WOMEN - SEMINAR BY CAREER LAUNCHER

On 4 February 2025, Eclat, the Economics Association of Daulat Ram College, organized a seminar on "ACE CAT FOR WOMEN" in collaboration with Career Launcher. The session featured Ms. Sujatha Kshirsagar, President of Career Launcher and IIM Bangalore alumna, and was attended by students from various colleges including Miranda House, Hansraj, IGDTUW, and Kamla Nehru. Aimed at encouraging women to pursue careers in management, the seminar focused on the importance of strategic planning, perseverance, and logical aptitude for cracking the CAT exam. Ms. Kshirsagar highlighted the increasing gender diversity efforts in B-school admissions and engaged students with practical problem-solving using previous CAT questions. The event proved to be both motivating and insightful, reinforcing Eclat's commitment to empowering students through meaningful career guidance.



## NITI GUPSHUP

Eclat, the Economics Association of Daulat Ram College, successfully organized Niti Gupshup, a policy discussion forum on 15 February 2025, centered on the theme "Balancing Global Integration and Local Self-Sufficiency: A Swadeshi Perspective." The event brought together students from varied academic backgrounds to engage in a thought-provoking dialogue on the evolution of the Swadeshi movement—from a nationalist strategy to a broader framework aligned with India's global economic ambitions. Key issues such as consumer choice, trade balance, the export readiness of Indian firms, and the influence of political leadership on trade policies were explored in depth. Participants also discussed comparative models like China and South Korea, and examined the role of budget allocations and R&D investment in bolstering India's global competitiveness. The forum stood out for its intellectual rigor and critical insights, serving as a dynamic platform to foster policy-oriented thinking and a nuanced understanding of India's path toward self-reliant globalization.



## MUTASIR-THE ANNUAL YOUTH CONFERENCE



Mutasir'25, the Annual Youth Conference hosted by ÉCLAT, the Economics Association of Daulat Ram College, was a resounding success. . Centered around the theme "Economics of Marginalisation", the conference delved into issues such as economic inequality, policy inefficiencies, and the challenges faced by marginalised communities.

Distinguished speakers Prof. Ram Singh, Member of MPC of India, Prof. Surjit Mazumdar, and Prof. Rohini Somanathan offered powerful insights—ranging from myth-busting around inequality narratives and the global impact of globalisation to gender biases in academia, referencing Nobel Laureate Claudia Goldin's work. A standout moment included a reading from the biography of Jean Dickinson Gibbons by Prof. Somanathan. The event featured keynote speeches, in-depth presentations, and interactive Q&A sessions that encouraged critical thinking and empathy toward vulnerable populations.



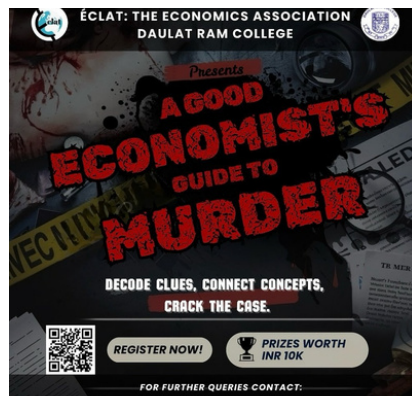

Guided by judges Dr. R. Ahalya and Ms. Akansha, teams proposed two-phase solutions: an Immediate Action Plan and a Long-Term Growth Strategy. The event promoted critical thinking, collaboration, and practical policy design. It concluded with closing remarks by Ms. Shikha Singh and the announcement of winners, marking a successful and insightful experience.



## FINVENGERS

FinVengers, organized by the Finance Department of Éclat, The Economics Association of Daulat Ram College, was a high-stakes financial competition where teams acted as financial superheroes, building mutual fund portfolios amid market booms, crashes, and crises. Spanning four rounds, the event challenged participants to tackle scenarios like interest rate hikes, corporate scandals, and global recessions, testing their risk analysis and strategy skills. After intense rounds, Team Ceteris Paribas (Gopala Savyasanchi & Siddhant Samuel Khanna) emerged victorious, with Team Alpha (Ayush Bansal & Vivek Kumar) as runners-up. The event successfully blended finance and strategy, sharpening participants' investment acumen and adaptability.

## A GOOD ECONOMIST'S GUIDE TO MURDER

Each article provides a critical perspective on contemporary developments shaping India's economic landscape.

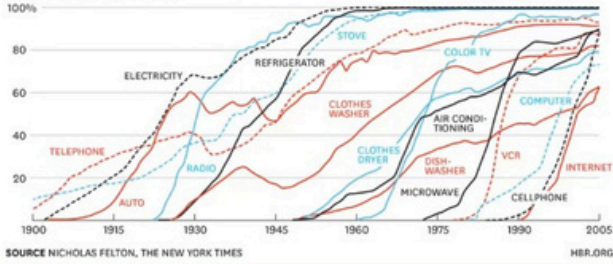
