WORD SEARCH PUZZLE

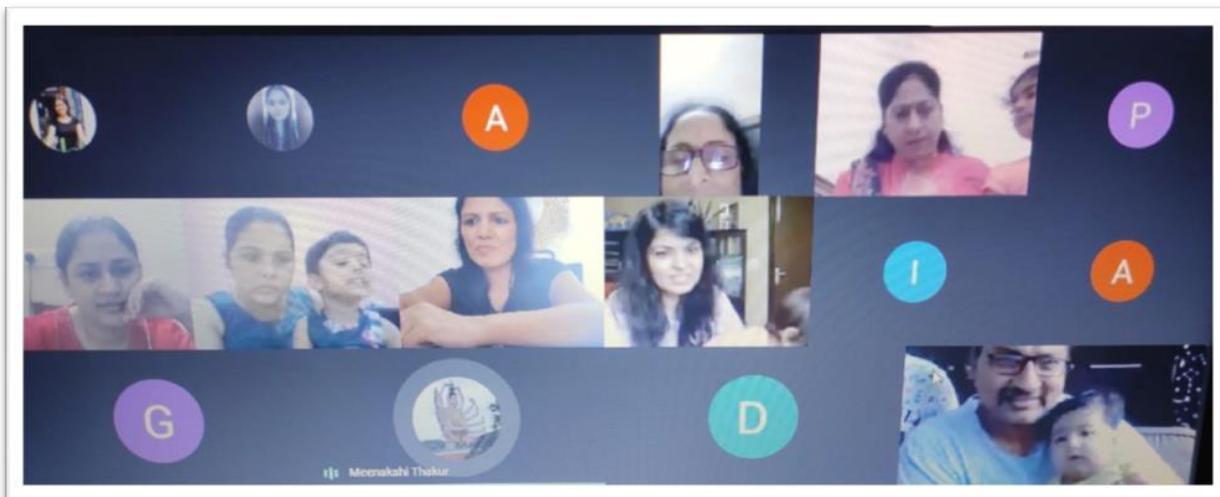
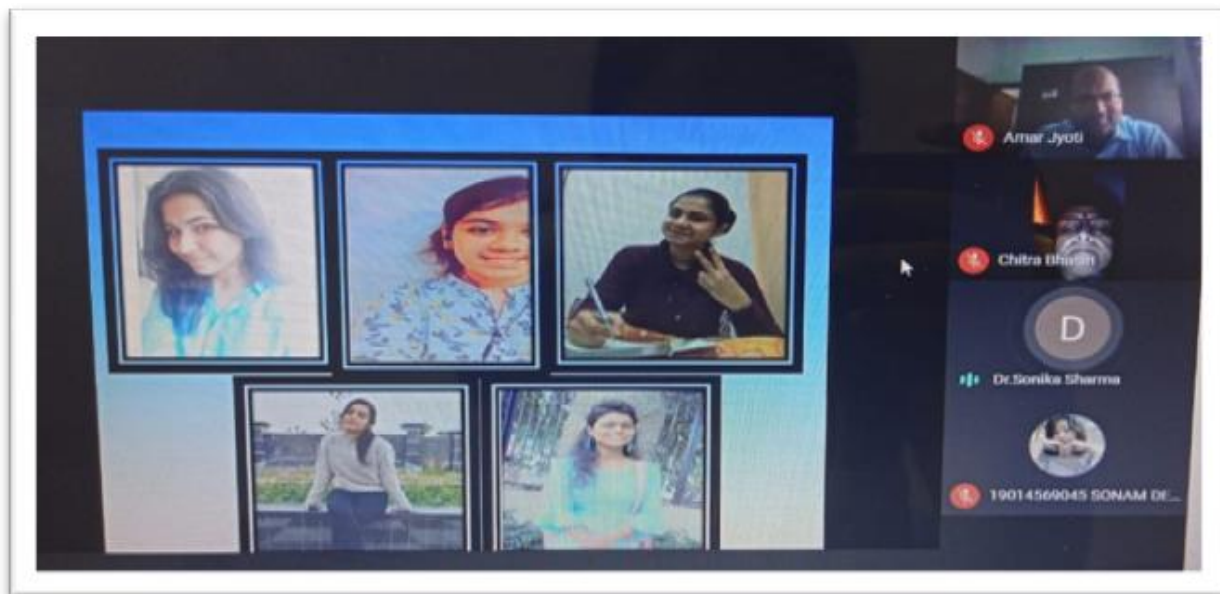
With the union now complete an intra departmental word search puzzle was organised on the topic 'Marine Word' to create awareness among the students about marine life on 13th January 2021 in



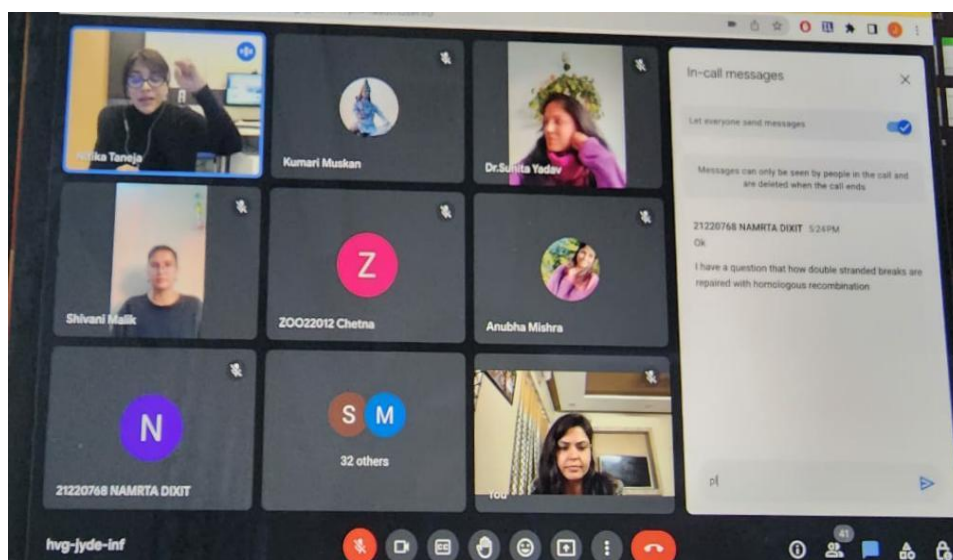
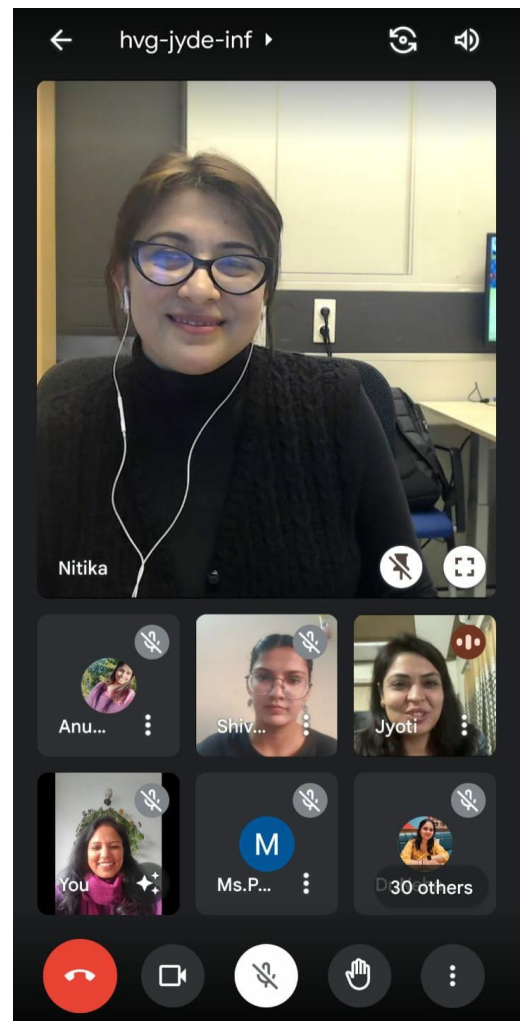

COGNOSCERE'23: *Hallmarks of Being*, the annual fest of **KOSHIKA: The Zoological Society**, Daulat Ram College was held on 8th February 2023 in the college premises. There was a good response from students for the general registration form. The form closed after recording 250 general registration responses. The fest was inaugurated with an informative talk on the topic "Connection Between Reproductive Hormones, Mental and Physical Being that you must know", which was addressed by **Professor Rita Singh**. She is the Professor and Chair, Division of Molecular Endocrinology and Reproduction, Department of Zoology, University of Delhi. A total of 130 registrations were received for the talk session. The event was then followed by three competitions namely Quiz-a-Thon, Kibitz,

and Zoogalbandi.
