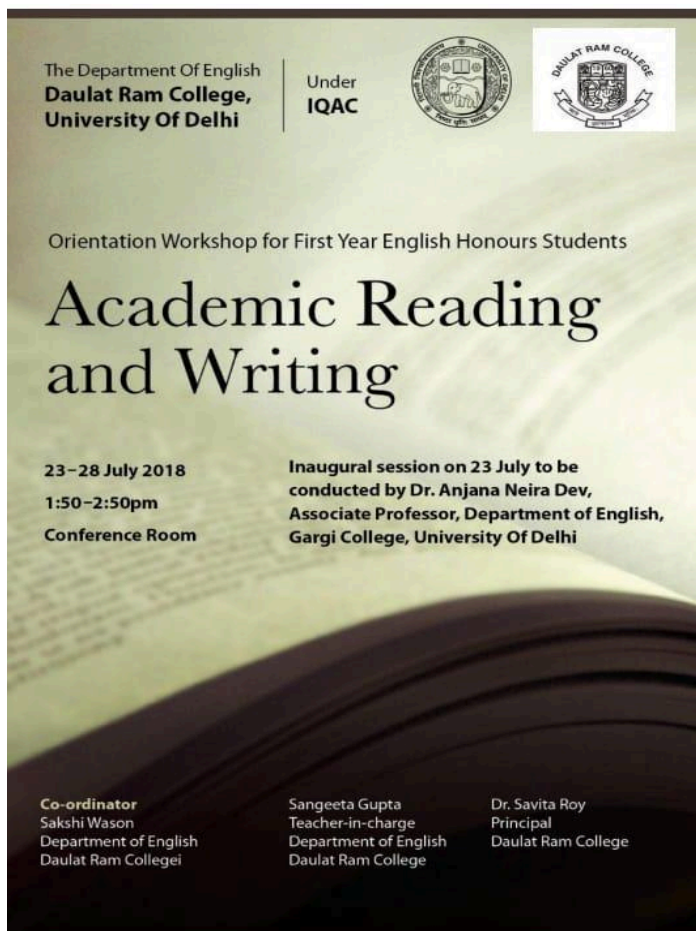

Report on RBPT Workshop

The Department of Zoology celebrated its golden jubilee year in 2018-2019 by organizing various workshops and seminars. In the year 2019 from March 25th to 27th 'Research Based Pedagogical Tools (RBPT)' Workshop for Science Teachers was organized along with IISER Pune as Knowledge partners. More than 40 teachers from various colleges of Delhi University attended the workshop. Inaugural session included talk by two eminent academicians.

Dr Arun Kumar Pandey, Vice-Chancellor, Mansarovar Global University, Bhopal talked about amalgamation of conventional methods and technology in the teaching learning arena. Dr. Pratibha Jolly gave an inaugural talk on the topic "Undergraduate Science Education Guiding Change, Transforming Ecosystems".

Dr.Savita Roy, Principal Daulat Ram College emphasized on making the teaching learning process more student-centric. She said the practical component is very important and the students must be encouraged to do an activity by themselves to learn. Prof.M.M. Chaturvedi gave a valedictory lecture on the topic "Fourth Revolution in Education (E 4.0)".

Dr.Vandana Luthra, Dr. Sudhir Verma and Dr Mallika Pathak conducted the workshop as RBPT trainers. Major themes included Introduction of RBPT, development & analysis of RBPT and presenting the RBPT.

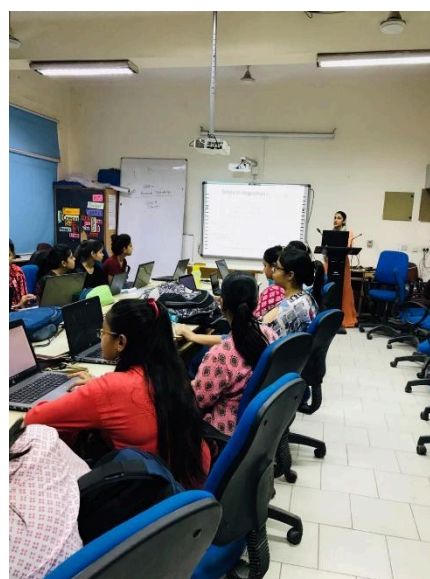
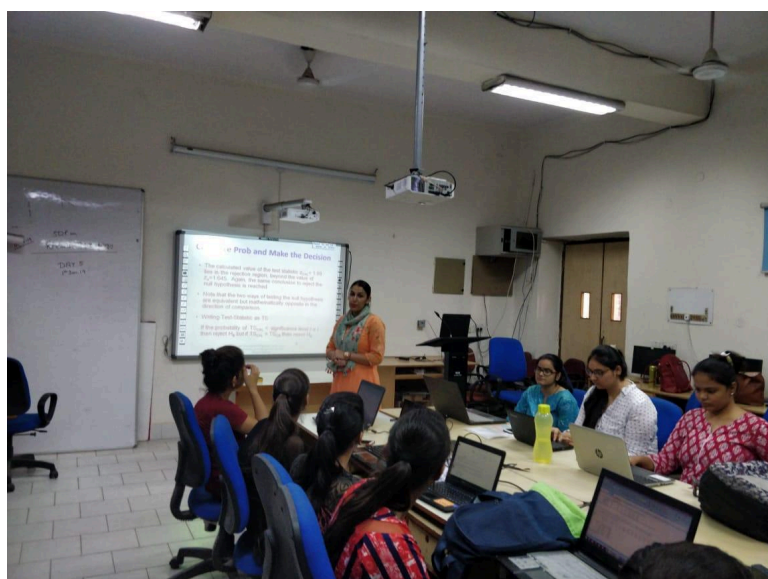

Summary of the Event:

Students were introduced to Research Methodology and Research Process in Session 1. Thereafter, the 7 steps in preparing Research Proposal often acronymed as TIPOLiMeR were discussed. On day 2 , students were introduced to the concept of Types of Research, Sampling Design and Sampling Error and Measurement Scales and Types of Measurement Scale were explained. Day 3 was about Data Types and Data Collection Process and Secondary Data Analysis using MS Excel. Next day, Hypothesis Formulation and Hypothesis Testing along with questionnaire designing for research investigation. Sessions on Day 5 and 6 included Primary Data Analysis and Mixed Method Approach. On the final day, how to prepare a Research Report was discussed. Later, group presentations were made by all the participants to use the learnings of the workshop to do a small research on topics of their interest.

Zebrafish Lab Facility Daulat Ram College

The zebrafish lab facility in Daulat Ram College was set up in October 2015, jointly by Biochemistry and Zoology Departments in collaboration with CSIR-IGIB, Mathura Road, Delhi, and Sansriti Foundation Delhi. The facility has been funded by Star Innovation projects DU, Star College project DBT, Govt. of India, and Innovation projects DU. It was developed with the aim of providing an alternative *in vivo non –invasive model system for science education, teaching and research*.

Students of Biochemistry (Hons), Zoology (Hons) and Life Sciences join the lab as interns and work on research projects during their free time and holidays. This opportunity provides students with experiences wherein they can explore and discover the nature and process of scientific research using zebrafish model system. Small internship programs are also conducted for school students.

Zebrafish lab facility organized the following training workshop and training programs:

- Hands on training workshop on “ **Drosophila and Zebrafish model systems**” 28th -31st , 2019 May was jointly organized with Dr. Chitra Bhasin of Zoology department, for science teaching faculty of Delhi University Colleges. 15 teachers participated in the workshop.
- Summer Internship Program for science undergraduate students of Delhi University was organized from 17th June – 17th July 2019, on “ **Zebrafish Model System**” at Zebrafish facility, Daulat Ram College. 15 students participated.
- One day training program on “ **Zebrafish Husbandry**” was organized for Zoology Hons. Students of Khalsa College, University of Delhi on 24th September, 2019. 50 students participated in the workshop.

- Hands on training workshop on “**Zebrafish model system**” was conducted from 17th Dec – 20th December 2019 in Zebrafish lab facility, Daulat Ram College. 15 undergraduate students of Zoology (Hons) Ist year Daulat Ram College participated in the workshop
- Two PhD Scholars from Ashoka University, Haryana, underwent training in “**Zebrafish Husbandry**” in January 2020.

Small research projects undertaken by faculty and students in Zebrafish lab facility have resulted in one publication in UGC approved journal and 4 poster presentations in National and International Conferences.

Zebrafish lab facility also serves as a resource center to provide zebrafish and embryos to other colleges/ departments and research institutes to support teaching and lab practicals.

Having a good foundation of research at any level may help in pursuing a research career in the future. Thus, the study of research methodology in chemistry is important as it provides researchers pursuing chemical research, the necessary training in choosing methods, materials, scientific tools and training in techniques relevant for the problem chosen.

From initiation of a research idea to the ultimate culmination in publication there are many segments in the research methodology. In order to productively utilize the lockdown due to Covid 19 pandemic for academic pursuits, Department of Chemistry, Daulat Ram College organized Online Summer Internship Programme on “**Research Methodology for Chemistry**” for undergraduate and postgraduate students during **16th to 30th May 2020** under the able guidance of Principal, Dr Savita Roy and programme convenor, Dr Priti Malhotra, Co-Convenor Dr Arti Jain. The session was inaugurated with the talk by Dr Rakesh Parashar for the Department of Chemistry, DU who talked about “**Safe handling of Lab chemicals and optimum use of prevalent chemicals for Corona prevention**”.

150 students participated in the internship program and get familiarized with the use of softwares and statistical tools for data analysis, scientific instruments, safe handling of lab chemicals, research metrics, formulation of research problems, literature review, how to write research publications and scientific posters, how to access e-journals, plagiarism and research ethics. The students also learnt about biological and chemical research in the context of Covid 19 and optimum use of chemicals for corona prevention such as medicines and sanitizers. The participants submitted research articles and scientific posters as part of the assessment in the internship. Also at the end of each module they had to answer multiple choice questions to analyse their understanding of the topic taught.

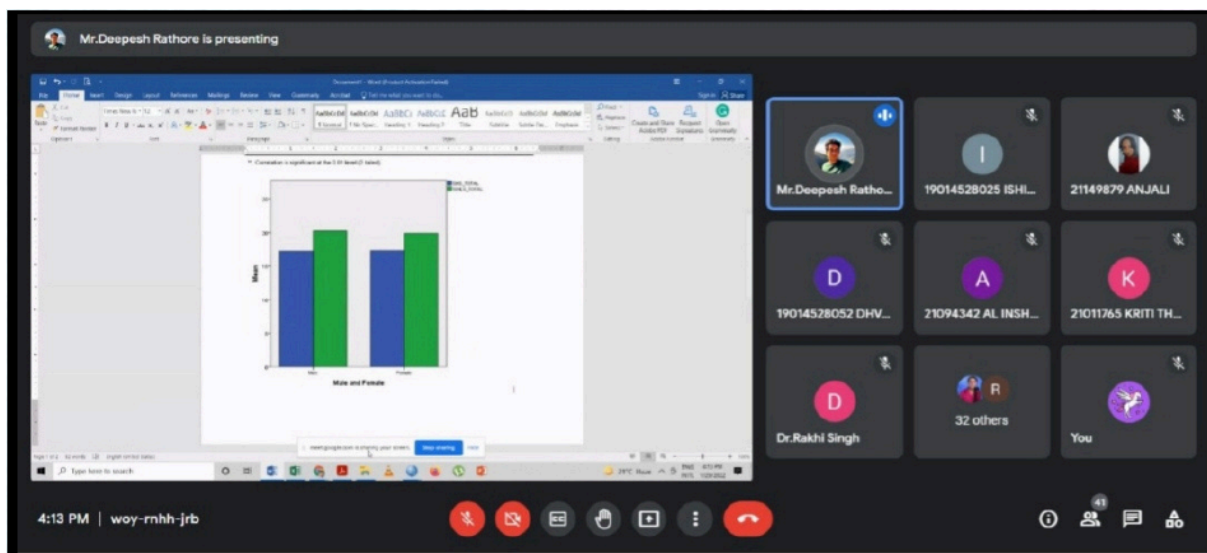

BRIEF REPORT OF WORKSHOP ON DROSOPHILA AS MODEL ORGANISM

Two-day workshop was organized by Drosophila Resource Centre, Dept. of Biochemistry on 22nd and 29th September 2022. Third year students (24) and two faculties from Biochemistry Department of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women participated in the workshop.

The workshop covered the following practicals:

1. Introduction to various model organisms and why is drosophila used as model organism
2. Maintenance and culturing of drosophila
3. Male female differentiation and collection of virgin flies
4. Study of lifecycle stages of drosophila
5. To study mutant phenotypes of *Drosophila melanogaster*
6. To separate eye pigments (pterins) by thin layer chromatography
7. To prepare stained squashes of salivary glands showing well spread polytene chromosomes

Few experiments were shown as demonstration in small groups (food preparation etc.), few others were observation-based, while hands-on-training was given for maintenance and culturing of drosophila, separation of eye pigments by TLC and preparation of stained squashes of salivary glands showing well spread polytene chromosomes.



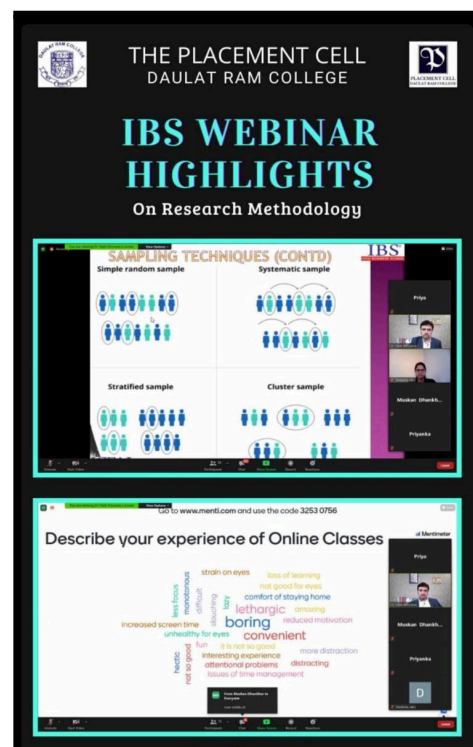
Summary of the Event:

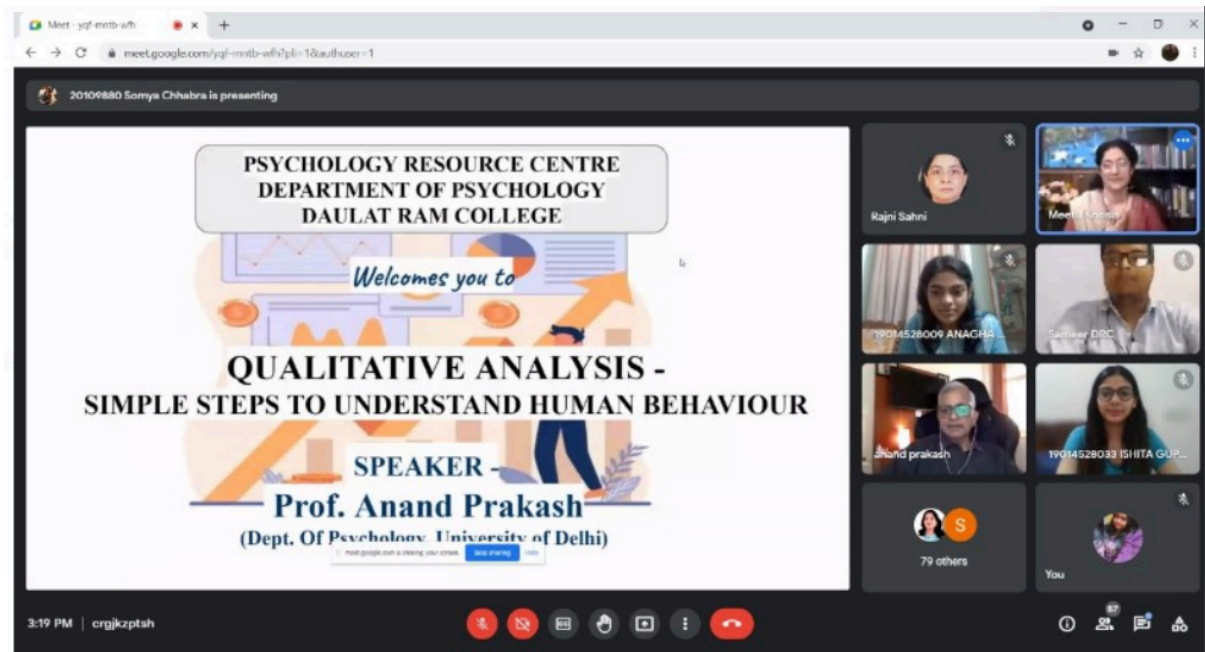

Department of Zoology and Biochemistry, Daulat Ram College, University of Delhi in collaboration with Sansriti Foundation organised a 15 days Internship training on **“DROSOPHILA MODEL SYSTEM”** sponsored by **Star College project, DBT, Govt. of India**. The Convener of the internship was Dr. Chitra Bhasin and Co Convener Dr. Padmshree Mudgal.

The Drosophila Training Program was initiated to provide participants with practical skills and comprehensive knowledge about *Drosophila melanogaster*. *Drosophila*, commonly known as fruit flies, and serve as an excellent model organisms in various scientific studies due to their short life cycle, genetic tractability, and similarity to human genome in many aspects. The primary objective of the training program was to equip the students with the necessary theoretical background on model organisms and hands-on experience to effectively conduct *Drosophila* research. Participants were expected to gain proficiency in *Drosophila* genetic manipulation techniques, experimental design, data collection, and analysis.

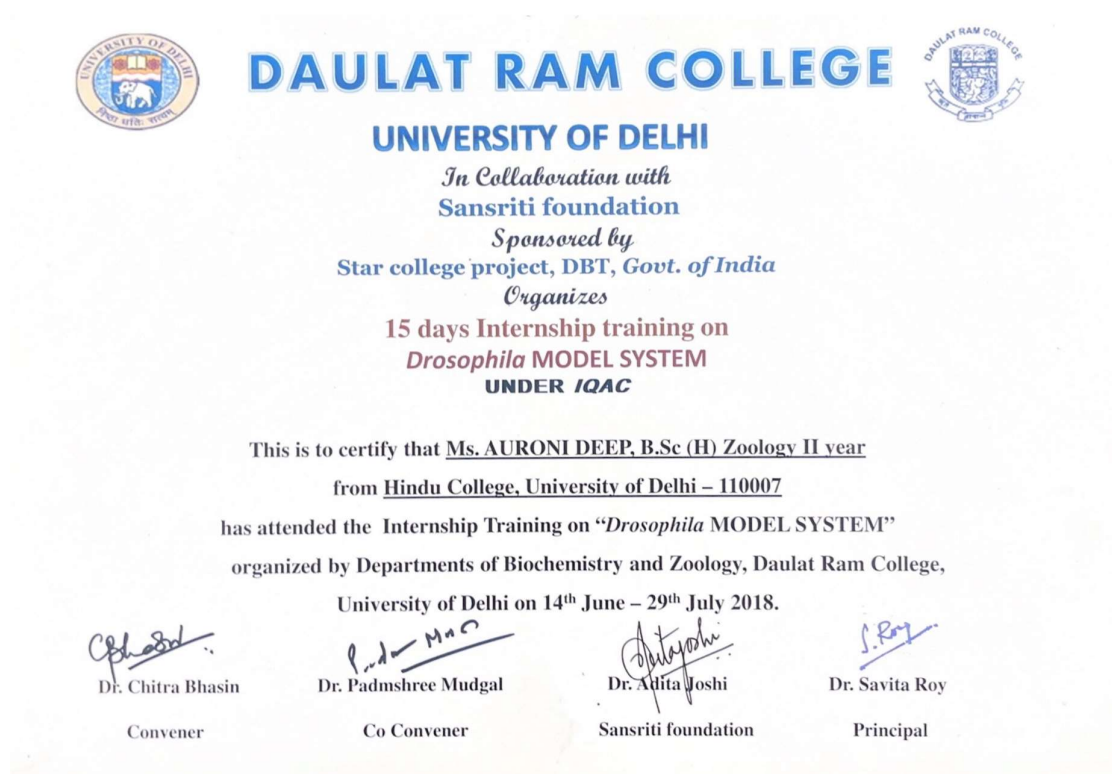
A total of 22 students participated in this internship training program. Students studied the life cycle of *Drosophila*. Everyone had a hand on training on maintaining and handling flies in laboratory; gender selection; media preparation etc. Once the trainees were acclimated with *Drosophila*, they designed mating schemes and Mendelian genetics. All the participants studied the following aspects of *Drosophila* research:

- Mutants and balancer chromosomes
- Collection of eggs for studying embryogenesis
- Larval instars, pupae and adults: Morphology and Anatomy
- Salivary glands chromosomes and Autosomes (Mitotic) chromosomes preparation
- Chromatography and isolation of eye pigments
- Temporary mounting of ommatidia, ovaries, testes, cuticular denticles, brain, imaginal disc, sex combs with dapi staining in wild type and mutant of larvae and adults
- Linkage studies and Chi-square analysis

- Genotype to phenotype-White & red eye mutants; DNA isolation and PCR analysis
- Research Methodology and basic data analysis
- Activities on Nature and process of Science
- Interactive sessions and important Drosophila search sites, tools etc.
- Olfaction behaviour studies using Y Maze and T Maze systems.

Conclusion:

This training session provided the participants with comprehensive knowledge on maintenance, physiology and genetics of *Drosophila melanogaster*.
